

Timbertown Heritage Theme Park is an entire village, re-created to demonstrate the struggles and achievements of Australian pioneers set amidst the tall timbers of an 87 acres natural forest at Wauchope on the mid north coast of New South Wales.

It's an authentic 1880's colonial township, where the horse drawn carriage still takes visitors on a forest tour around the 87 acres, timber is still sawn and an impressive bullock team still hauls it's heavy load.

Enjoy the distinctive aroma of wood fired steam from the sawmill, the fresh clean smell of freshly sawn woods and the tantalizing scent of a fine home cooked meal. Every sense will be touched with the essence of this era as you gently travel back in time to this special part of our national heritage.

Timbertown is a great place to visit for children of all ages, family, friends, corporate and social groups. It's a great venue for sheer relaxation, education, corporate team building or a great night out.

Massive, strong, red devon bullocks draw crowds to the Timbertown arena twice daily for a well coordinated bullock demonstration. There is something for everyone at Timbertown – so much to see and do:

Timbertown is located along the Oxley Highway, West of Wauchope (pronounced war-hope!) 20 minutes drive inland from Port Macquarie and only 10kms off the Pacific Highway. It is easily accessible from the Pacific Highway either travelling North from Sydney, South from Brisbane, or East along the Oxley Highway from Walcha.

Timbertown, opened in 1976 is considered to be one of Australia's finest Heritage Parks, annually welcoming more than 80,000 visitors from around the world.
